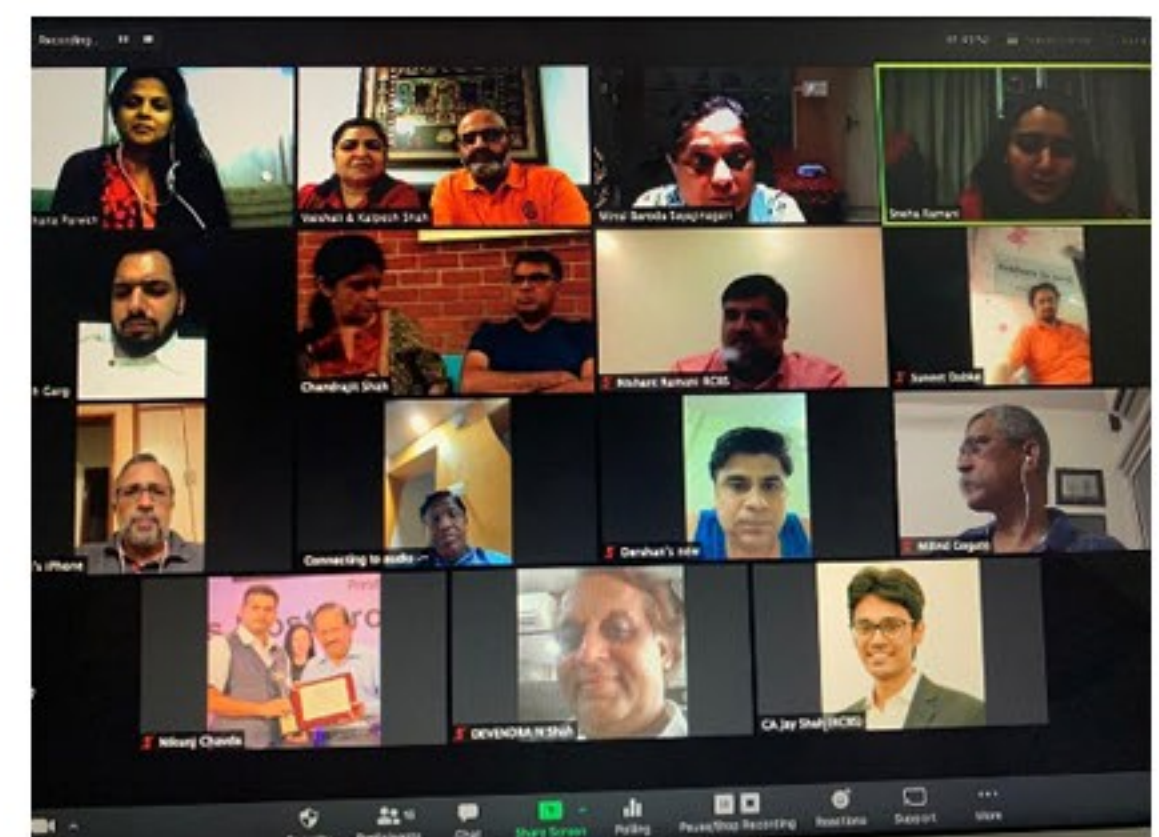
CLUB ASSEMBLY

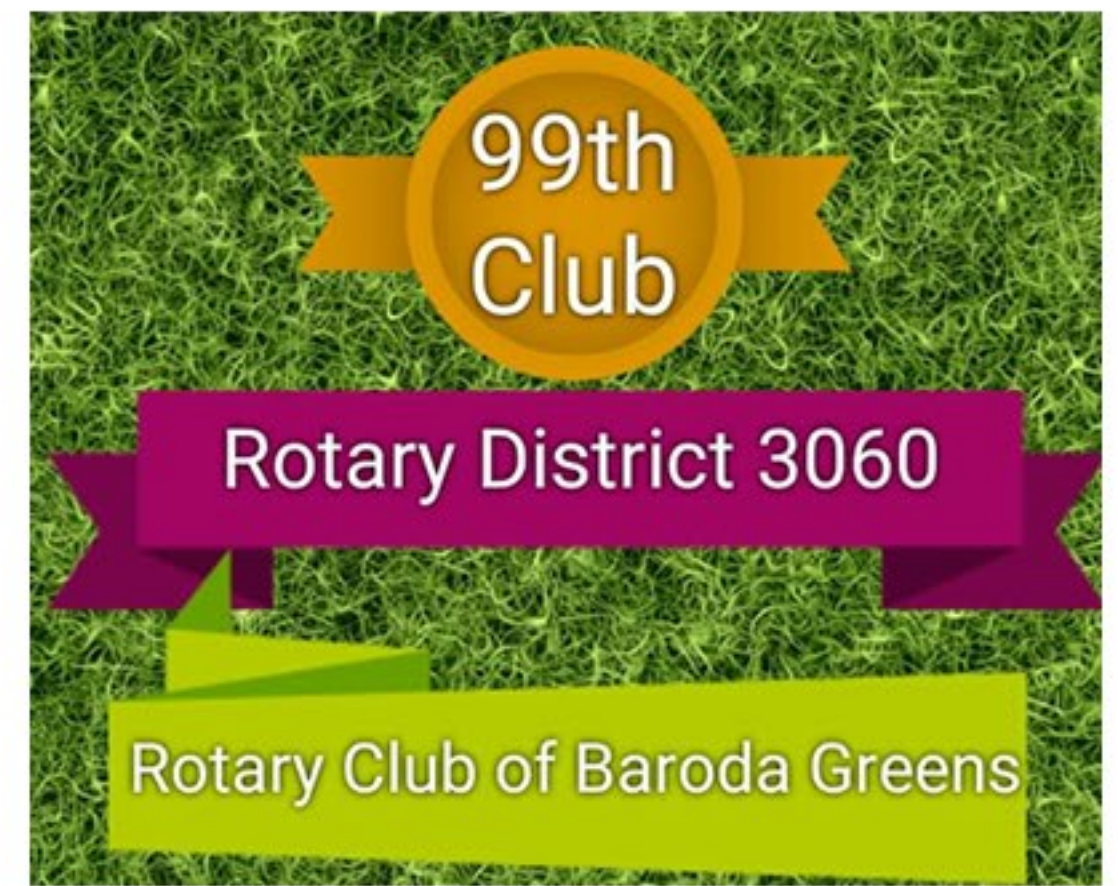

Congratulations to Rtn Pritesh Shah for achieving award for outstanding contribution in quality and excellence from INDIA 5000 BEST MSME Award 2020.

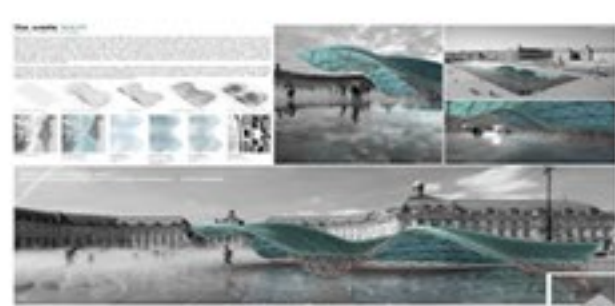

How Digital Innovation can fight Pandemics and strenghten Democracy

Taiwan is the most open & liberal society in whole of Asia. Apart from freedom of speech & assembly as other liberal democracies, it keeps open mind to novel ideas from the society. It has conquered COVID due to Digital Democracy Tools- Fast, Fair & Fun.

Fast: Their medical officers immediately noticed Dr. Li Wenliang's whistle blower post that SARS is back and issued an order on 1st Jan to do health check ups for passengers on flights from Wuhan to Taiwan. Here, the civil society trusts the government enough to talk about possible new SARS in the public forum and the government trusts its citizens to take it seriously. Everyday Central Epidemic Command Centre holds a press conference which is always live streamed where they answer journalists and take ideas from citizens. This rapid response system builds trust between government and the civil society.

Fair: All citizens can use their national health insurance card to collect masks from nearby pharmacies. They publish the stock level of masks of all 6000 pharmacies every 30 sec so everybody has access to information. National Insurance has 99.9% of health coverage so if people show any symptoms they go to local clinic knowing fully that they will get treated fairly without incurring any financial burden.

Fun: Their counter disinformation strategy for panic buying and conspiracies in economics is very simple. Its called "Humour over Rumour". They believe factual humour spreads faster than rumour. So they made animations or fun statements for social distancing, sanitising etc.
