Rtn. President Umed Fifadra has been a Rotarian since January 1996. He joined during presidency of Rtn.PP **Dr. Sanjay Pandit** and was sponsored by **Rtn. PP Capt.** Raniit Pradhan.

His did his BE from Walchand College of Engineering in 1974 and went to USA to pursue the Masters in Engineering and graduated in 1977.

Umed Married to Usha on 26 June 1977 at Mumbai and went back to USA to pursue his dream. Usha joined him in Oct 1977. Chirag , their son was born on 4 July 1980 and Daughter, Roshni on 24 October 1983.

During those years in USA , he worked with multinational companies as Instrumentation Engineer. Finally, he joined Occidental Petroleum in 1982 as Staff Measurement Engineer to monitor and measure the total production of Oil and Gas their Oil Field in Libya. He worked 24 days and on and 24 days off. During his off days he started to visit India to explore the business opportunity in Oil and Gas Measurement Field. Finally, moved to India in 1987 with family and since then settled in Vadodara.

After moving to Vadodara, he formed Joint Venture company with Spectra Tek UK Ltd. with Mukesh Kapadia as co-promoter. The company Advanced Spectra Tek Pvt. Ltd. Started manufacturing Flow Measuring Computers in India (Import Substitute). In short span of two years, captured the 90% of Oil and Gas Measurement market in India. Also first time introduced Petroleum Product Truck loading automation system to stop pilferage of petroleum products while filling of tank truck which delivers to petrol Pump.

Chirag and Roshni moved to USA for further studies. **Chirag** graduated in BS n MS from Cornell University and MBA from North Carolina University. Roshni completed her BS in Business and MBA from University of Houston. Both are married and settled in USA. Chirag has Two sons, Amar (12) and Akash (7).

In 2012, **Umed** and **Mukesh** sold majority stake in their company to GE. And bought back the stake from GE in Dec. 2017 . Since than the company is progressing well and now run by a team of professionals.

Umed loves to travel and enjoys watching movies. He is actively involved as Trustee in Alkapuri Sthanakwasi Jain Sangh and Pawandham Sangh.

In RCBJ he would like to promote support to Girls education, tribal school and drinking water projects in rural area.






