# SPEAKER MEETING - 11.03.2025 (Report by Ann Twisha Jhala)

A big thank you to PP Rtn. Bharat Shah and PP Rtn. Jagdish Thakkar for getting Mr. Andreas Foerster, Managing Director of Tata Advanced Systems to talk to us about the prestigious projector Flying Dragon C295 coming up in Vadodara.

After Sgt-at-arms Rtn. Dipak Patel had called the meeting to order followed by melodious prayer by Ann Nita Shah. Rtn. PP Rtn Vivek Patel reminded us of the 4 way test.

After the opening remarks from Pres. Rtn. Umedbhai, Rtn. Vineet Jain and First Lady Ushaben florally welcomed Mr. Andreas and Ann Aditi Vahia welcomed his wife with a bouquet. While the chief guest escorted by PP Rtn Bharat **Shah** took to the dias he was introduced by **PP. Rtn.** Bharatbhai along with his lovely wife Leli.

Mr. Andreas after his Bachelor's Degree in Mechanical Engineering from Berlin and Master's Degree from MIT had a prestigious, successful career with Airbus for 30 years before joining Tata Advanced Systems as MD to lead the implementation of C-295 final assembly line in Vadodara.

Mr. Andreas then took over the floor with his lucid audio visual presentation that took the audience through his interesting 30 years journey with Airbus leading to his joining Tata since 30 months.

Some interesting facts that came to light were that Indigo has bought about 500 planes from Airbus. Airbus and Tata are also collaborating for Military Helicopters Project to be set up in Banglore. 11.3.93 was also the first commercial flight of A321 that took off from Hamburg, Germany. It was while travelling through Europe for pre-study for A380 that he met his wife in Spain.

It was heartwarming to learn that Tata was much much bigger than Airbus which generates about 70 billion dollars per year. Moreover the ethics in excellence, integrity and safety that Tata doesn't compromise on are at par with anywhere in the world. It was interesting to learn that military activities of Tata whether related to land, air or sea is being generated in Banglore and Hyderabad and many Aeronautical parts are provided all over the world by Tata.

In conclusion, Rotary's commitment to WASH projects plays a very decisive role in improving the quality of life, particularly in underserved regions. Through strategic partnerships and dedicated efforts, Rotary continues to transform lives by providing access to clean water and improved sanitation, fostering healthier and more sustainable communities worldwide.

For the first time Vadodara has entered on the map of Aeronautics when 40 of the 56 scheduled C295 that can carry upto 50 parachuters will roll out from Vadodara. There is already one C295 standing on the tarmac of Vadodara Airport that has been brought in from Spain.

He highlighted the difficulties where about 300 people consisting of Engineers and Technicians have been brought in from about 27 states and many have been sent for about 18 months to Spain for training. The first flight of C295 is expected from FAL, Vadodara by June 2026.

This was followed by a lively question and answer session where umpteen questions were thrown at him by Rtn. Dr. Pinkal Shah, PP Rtn. Chandresh Makhija, Rtn. Rajal, Rajeev Jandial, PP. Rtn. Hemang Vahia, PP. Rtn. Bharat Shah and PP. Rtn. Chhabraji.

Mr. Andreas ended his talk with a 3 minute video showing the inside of the Hangar.

This interesting and informative talk ended with a Momento of Appreciation being presented to Mr. Andreas and his wife by Pres. Rtn. Umedbhai, PP Rtn.Bharatbhai and PP Rtn. Jagdishbhai.

After the secretarial announcements by Hon Secretary PP. Rtn. Hemangbhai lucky lady prize was announced which went to Guest of Honor Leli.
