# → Rotary Club of Baroda Jawaharnagar - National Immunization Day 8th Dec 24 → (A Report by Club Polio Chair-Rtn.PP Dr.Jayant Sastry)

Under the able leadership of Club Polio Chair **Rtn.PP Dr.Jayant Sastry**, Rotary Club of Baroda Jawaharnagar (RCBJ) once again participated wholeheartedly in the National Immunization Day on Polio Ravivaar i.e. on Sunday 8th December, 2024. Continuing the good work which RCBJ has been doing since more than 40 years, this year too we provided 40 vehicles (Sponsored magnanimously by Rotarians of RCBJ) to transport vaccinators to immunization booths. We covered 40 Urban Health Centres thereby covering 876 booths. The total number of persons transported to and from the booths @ 4/booth came to more than 3500 persons. The number of Under-5 beneficiaries covered came to 2,10,000 with our support.

Heartiest Congratulations to Club Polio Chair- Rtn.PP Dr. Jayant Sastry for the good work that he is doing selflessly and the yeomen services rendered and the Rotarians of RCBJ for coming forward spontaneously to sponsor the vehicles.

# + RCBJ PERMANENT PROJECT: ROTARY BOSCH BRIDGE PROGRAM +

This is to introduce and provide information for the **Rotary Bosch Bridge Program (RBBP)** to all members of RCBJ.

### What is the Bridge Program.

To impart the soft skill by way of teaching the backward area students like spoken English, introductory course for the computer operation, public speaking, and introduction of the different Student must be with minimum age of 18 years.

- 1) The program is for the students from backward areas of Gujarat State.
- 2) The tenure of the program for each batch is for two months.
- 3) The minimum batch should be of 25 students.
- 4) The dedicated instructor is selected by each centre by taking interviews, training, and passing tests conducted by BOSCH.
- 5) The duties of a trainer teacher are as follows.
  - Before starting the batch of students, he/she will visit the villages around the Centre.
  - Make aware of the prospective students for the feature of this program.
  - Instructor will enroll them by filling the forms printed by centers.
  - Once the minimum batch of 10 and more students are ready to be enrolled, he/she has to inform the management of the school and RCBJ for the starting date.

# The criteria for the selected Teaching Centre

- 1. Centre must have a separate teaching hall where they can accommodate a minimum 25 students.
- 2. Proper sitting arrangement with benches and the white board should be there.
- 3. Projector with a screen should be there in the classroom.
- 4. Separate tutor for teaching this course other than the school staff
- 5. Computer lab with sufficient computers to be there for the students.
- 6. Students have to pay a deposit and the money deposited is retained by the centre. The deposit amount is refunded after two months of completion of course and clearing the exams taken by BOSCH.

The Rotary Bosch Bridge program was launched with 130 Students at Muni Seva Ashram (MSA) Goraj on August 12<sup>th</sup> 2024 at their VTC training centre.

### **First Centre**

The Rotary Bosch Program's first centre was launched at Nalanda Vidyalaya at Ghoghamba village in Panchmahal District. The program was launched on 23 September 2024 with 25 students in the first batch.

On Oct 8, 2024 - MSA and RCBJ members – **Rtn.President Umed Fifdra, PP Manoj Adalja** and **myself** visited Nalanda Vidyalaya to meet the students. We were extremely happy at the progress of the Bridge program at Nalanda Vidyalaya.

<u>Six students from the first batch have received employment offers after completion of the 2 months course.</u>

# **Second Centre:**

With the success of first centre, we have launched second centre at Don Bosco school Kawant, on 7<sup>th</sup> January 2025. There are 34 students enrolled for the course.

Since the second centre at The Don Bosco School is temporarily equipped with needed equipment and minimum arrangement, they need the following equipment :

- Minimum 20 Computers.
- 20 Student benches.
- 20 sets of translated books (In Gujarati) for their course.
- White Board.

Since our club is the promoter of this second centre, I request all the RCBJ members to donate and support generously for the much needed equipment.

This information is for all my fellow Rotarians of RCBJ and I would like to request all of you to participate with this program and support towards future development. Kindly contact me for any questions.

I will keep RCBJ members updated as this progresses further.
