→ When we met last Tuesday 12th Nov-2024 →

First Lady **Usha Fifadra** invoked the blessing of Lord Almighty for all the members of the Rotary Club of Baroda Jawaharnagar & their families. **Rtn. Manish Shah** reminded us of the Rotary's 4-Way Test a benchmark for living better and ethical lives.

President Umed Fifadra gave his opening remarks and set the meeting in motion.

Rtn.IPP Hiren Shah in his address, went down the memory lane recounting various Rotarians who had helped him in is his year as President. He dwelt upon projects done, Foundation Contribution (PDG Jatin Bhatt and Rtn.PP Dilip Shah — both becoming Major Donors, IPP Hiren Shah contributing USD 500 and Rtn.PP Chandresh Makhija contributing USD 100) given and a glimpse of the year that went by. He remembered Late Rtn.PP Keshav Mitra who was the Hon.Treasurer last year and who would have been presenting the accounts in his place had he not departed too early in life. He gave details of various heads in the accounts presented and answered question put up by members. The Accounts of the Rotary Club of Baroda Jawaharnagar for the RY 2023-24 were then passed unanimously by the General Body — Proposed by Rtn.PP Dr.Sanjay Pandit and Seconded by Rtn.PP Jagdish Thakkar.

Rtn.PP Jagdish Thakkar then spoke elaborately about the Rotary Club of Jawaharnagar Charitable Trust Accounts and the Trust in General taking everyone down the memory lane bringing everyone upto date about the position of the Trust as on the current date. His fluency about various facts and figures without referring to any papers was amazing. He urged Rotarians to contribute to the Trust generously. The Accounts of the Rotary Club of Jawaharnagar Charitable Trust were then passed unanimously by the General Body – Proposed by PP Manoj Adalja and Seconded by Rtn.Ashwin Majmundar.

Pres.Umed Fifadra then opened the discussion regarding the BOSCH Rotary Bridge Program to be implemented at the Nalanda School, Ghoghamba by our Club. He and Rtn.Kirit Dholakia gave an in-depth understanding to the General Body the various intricacies involved, how the implementation of the Program is extremely beneficial to the tribal children in getting trained and assured jobs. Various inputs were given by Rtn.PP Dr. Sanjay Pandit, Rtn.PP Manoj Adalja, Rtn.PP Chandresh Makhija, Rtn.Kamlesh M.Shah, Rtn.PP Ashutosh Jhala & Ann Twisha Jhala.

Rotary Foundation

The Rotary Foundation, established in 1917, is the philanthropic arm of Rotary International and globally it stands one of the largest humanitarian organizations. With a commitment to promote Peace, Health, and prosperity. It supports various projects addressing critical global challenges. Through a network of Rotary clubs in 200 countries, the foundation focuses on six core areas: promoting peace, fighting disease, providing clean water, supporting maternal and child health, enhancing education, and growing local economies.

One of the Foundation's hallmark initiatives is its fight against polio. Launched in 1985, the PolioPlus program has mobilized millions of Rotarians, healthcare professionals, and volunteers worldwide, resulting in the near-eradication of the disease. Through strategic partnerships with organizations such as the World Health Organization and the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, the Rotary Foundation has provided crucial funding and support, immunizing over 2.5 billion children against the disease and raising awareness about the importance of vaccinations.

Beyond health initiatives, the Rotary Foundation also prioritizes education and literacy. Programs like the Rotary Peace Fellowship offer opportunities for individuals from various backgrounds to gain advanced degrees in peace studies and conflict resolution. Additionally, the Foundation supports projects that enhance educational access and quality, from providing scholarships to building schools and training teachers, thereby empowering future generations with knowledge and skills.

In recognition of its impactful work, the Rotary Foundation has received numerous accolades and maintains a strong reputation for transparency and accountability in its operations.

After a lot of discussions and deliberations, the General Body decided unanimously that the implementation of the BOSCH Rotary Bridge Program at Nalanda School, Ghoghamba would now be a Permanent Program of our Club and generous contributions were requested from the RCBJ Rotarians. It was also decided that the Interest from the Deposits of Rotary Club of Baroda Jawaharnagar and the Deposits of the Rotary Club of Jawaharnagar Charitable Trust would be used to partly finance this Permanent Project of RCBJ. Approximately an amount of Rs.35,000 would be needed per month for paying the salaries of the teachers of the Nalanda School, Ghoghamba and each module would span over a period of 2 months. **Rtn.Kirit Dholakia** has already set the ball rolling by contributing the initial contribution of Rs.35,000 last month i.e. for the month of September, 2024. Each batch consists of 25-30 participants. The Next contribution is now due (payable after Diwali) in November 2024. The New Permanent Project of RCBJ was welcomed by all members with a thunderous applause. Kudos to **President Umed Fifadra** for initiating this Noble Project.

A Committee was formed for a period of 3 years comprising of Rtn.Kirit Dholakia (Co-ordinator), Rtn.PP Manoj Adalja, Rtn.PP Dilip Shah, Rtn.Chandresh Makhija & Rtn.PP Anita Jandial for the continuity and smooth functioning of this Project. Pres.Umed Fifadra and Hon.Sec.PP Hemang Vahia will be Ex Officio members of this committee. Interested Rotarians and Anns are most welcome to join this Project.

A Resolution was also passed by the General Body authorizing **Pres.Umed Fifadra** to cast the vote on behalf of RCBJ in the forthcoming Election for the District Governor Nominee 2027-28 at Bharuch on Sunday 15th December, 2024.

Tambola Master Rtn.PP Jagdish Thakkar (in his New Avatar) duly assisted by Ann Dr.Aditi Vahia and Ann Bhumi Shah then took over and an excellent round of Tambola ensued. The stylish Tambola Master conducted the Tambola flawlessly and the winners were:

+ GLIMPS OF THE LAST BOARD MEETING - 7th NOV 2024 +


- Pres. Umed Fifadra gave his Opening Remarks at the beginning of the Meeting.
- The MOM of the Meeting of the BOD held on 20.09.2024 were passed unanimously.
- The Accounts of the Rotary Club of Baroda Jawaharnagar for the FY 2023-24 were discussed extensively by the Board of Directors. Various aspects of the Accounts were discussed and certain recommendations were given regarding changes to be made in the Accounts of FY 2023-24. Thereafter, the Accounts of RCBJ for the FY 2023-24 were passed unanimously.
- The Accounts of the Rotary Club of Jawaharnagar Charitable Trust for the FY 2023-24 were discussed by the Board of Directors. After due deliberations, the Accounts of the Rotary Club of Jawaharnagar Charitable Trust for the FY 2023-24 were passed unanimously.

- The Meeting ended with a Vote of Thanks to the Chair.









