RCBJ Distributed Protein-Rich Nutrition Kits to Undernourished Pregnant Women

The third instalment of the Protein-Rich Nutrition Kit distribution drive was successfully completed on February 2nd, 2026, at two Urban Health Centres in the city, marking another significant milestone in the ongoing effort to combat maternal malnutrition.

The first distribution was held at 12:30 PM at Kishan wadi Urban Community Health Centre (UHC), followed by the second session at 4:30 PM at Atladara Urban Community Health Centre. The initiative focuses on supporting the most undernourished pregnant women within Municipal Corporation limits of Vadodara.

With the completion of three rounds of distribution on February 3, a total of 300 protein-rich supplement kits have been distributed over the past three months. Each kit contains one month's supply of essential grains and cooking oil, designed to provide additional protein and caloric intake to improve maternal health and promote safer pregnancies.

The overall target of the initiative is to distribute 600 kits. So far, 402 kits have been successfully provided to beneficiaries. While funds for one additional month are already secured, RCBJ now require support for two more months — 198 kits (200 bags approximately) — to reach the intended goal.

Healthcare staff and volunteers ensured smooth coordination during the program and guided beneficiaries on nutritional practices and maternal health awareness. The initiative has received encouraging community support, with Rotarians invited to witness and participate in the distribution process.

It is emphasized that sustained nutritional support during pregnancy is crucial for reducing health risks for both mother and child. They have appealed to donors and well-wishers to come forward and contribute toward the remaining 198 kits, helping the program achieve its target of 600 nutrition kits.

The drive reflects a strong commitment to improving maternal health outcomes and extending support to vulnerable expectant mothers during a critical phase of life.

RCBJ DISTRIBUTED REUSABLE SANITARY PADS

Reusable Sanitary Pads Distributed to Schoolgirls Under SBI CSR Initiative

In a significant step toward promoting menstrual hygiene awareness, reusable sanitary pads distribution project to schoolgirls the “RCBJ Team Achievers” joined in this initiative of Rotary District 3060. The project is spearheaded by the “Rotary Club of Rajkot Greater” in association with “Unipads Foundation” and supported under the CSR initiative of the “State Bank of India”.

The initiative has an ambitious objective — to educate and distribute 40,000 reusable sanitary pads to girls studying in Grades 8th to 12th across four cities: Rajkot, Bhavnagar, Vadodara, and Surat. The target is to donate 10,000 reusable pads in each city, exclusively covering government and semi-government schools. Private and trust-run schools are not included under this project.

As part of the program, a dedicated team of Anns / Ladies underwent structured online training on menstrual hygiene before visiting selected schools. The training component, logistics support, and sanitary pad kits were facilitated by Unipads Ahmedabad, ensuring proper implementation and quality distribution.

During the school sessions, volunteers educated students about menstrual hygiene management, addressed myths and taboos, and explained the benefits and usage of eco-friendly reusable sanitary pads. The initiative not only focused on distribution but also emphasized awareness and sustainable practices.

The sanitary pads were delivered directly to the schools free of cost, ensuring smooth coordination and maximum outreach. School authorities welcomed the initiative, noting its importance in improving attendance, confidence, and overall well-being among adolescent girls.

Organizers highlighted that the project reflects a strong commitment to health, dignity, and environmental responsibility. With a structured plan to reach 10,000 beneficiaries in each city, the campaign continues to move forward with the goal of empowering 40,000 young girls through education and sustainable menstrual hygiene solutions.
