ROTARY NEWS.....

Key decisions from the 2025 COL that impact the 2026-27 year include:

- 1. Membership Dues Increase:** Per capita dues for each Rotarian will increase from \$82 (2025-26) to \$85.50 for the 2026-27 Rotary year. The half-yearly payment for 2026-27 will be \$42.75.
- 2. Club Charter Size:** The minimum number of members required to charter a new Rotary club was reduced from 20 to 15.
- 3. Club/Member Termination Power:** The RI Board has enhanced power to suspend or terminate clubs or members who misuse Rotary Foundation funds or breach stewardship policies.
- 4. Club Naming Conventions:** The name "District Training Assembly" has been changed to "Club Leadership Learning Seminar"
