# A Dynamic Legacy of Service: District Governor Rtn. Amardeep Singh Bunet's Official Visit Marks a Grand Year for RCBJ

The air at Surya Palace on the evening of 9<sup>th</sup> April 2026 was charged with a palpable sense of pride and purpose. As the club marks its 59<sup>th</sup> year of service, the Official Club Visit (OCV) of District Governor Rtn. Amardeep Singh Bunet served as a powerful testament to what a dedicated group of Rotarians can achieve. From a day visit to Bosch high-tech skill center to grassroots nutrition projects at UHC, review of RY 25-26 with a full board meeting, meticulously planned press conference with wide print and media coverage, the evening was a masterclass in impactful humanitarian work.

The proceedings commenced with spiritual grace. Master of Ceremonies PP Rtn. Jagdish Thakker invoked the blessings of Lord Ganesh, setting a solemn tone for the evening. Following the meeting called to order by the Sgt-at-arms Rtn. Ashwin Majmundar, the traditional lighting of the lamp by DG Rtn. A S Bunet, President Rtn. Mitesh Vadhia, President-Elect Rtn. Girish Dhar, Club Public Chair PP Rtn. Dilip Shah and Hon. Secretary Manish Shah symbolizing the light of service that Rotary brings to the community. The melodic prayer by Ann Nita Shah and the recitation of the Four-Way Test by Rtn. Vinay Bhatt reminded all present of the ethical compass that guides every Rotary action.

President Rtn. Mitesh Vadhia's address was a highlight of the night, blending data with heartfelt stories of change. In less than a year, the club has already achieved 17 of its 21 assigned goals. The sheer scale of the work acknowledged by RI is staggering: 113 projects spanning education, youth empowerment, hygiene, and medical support. Notably, the club's environmental commitment was showcased through the planting of 700 trees and a robust e-waste collection drive. A standout achievement was the Flag Day fundraiser, which amassed 10 Lakhs, including a significant 1.5 Lakh donation to our Armed Forces welfare fund. This has significantly boosted visibility and impact of RCBJ as a club with "People of Action".

The Hon. Secretary Rtn. Manish Shah's audio-visual presentation further quantified this impact. With over 125 projects benefiting more than 20,400 individuals, the club has invested Rs. 30.7 Lakhs and nearly 4,000 man-hours into the community service this year alone. From the "Mission Unipad" menstrual hygiene initiative to the proposed collaboration with the Deepak Foundation for an Anganwadi Global Grant, the club's footprint is expanding.

Philanthropy was a central theme of the evening. The club honored Rtn. Rajubhai Shah for achieving Major Donor Level -2 (Rs.25Lakhs), a milestone that earned him a prestigious District Award.

Foundation Chair Rtn. Ashokbhai Shah further electrified the room by announcing a \$30,000 directed donation specifically for the Anganwadi project, with PP Rtn. Hemang Vahia tasked with drafting the Global Grant proposal to scale this initiative.

The human element of Rotary was beautifully captured as scholarship recipients Rathwa Vasant Kumar and Abudasar Abdul Sayal took to the stage, followed by moving testimonials from International Youth Exchange students Maria and Davin about their experience in India as students thus far.

In his keynote address, DG Rtn. Amardeep Singh Bunet was effusive in his praise. He specifically lauded the consistency of the Nutrition Kit project and the professional excellence of the BOSCH Skill Centre. He challenged the members to look forward, urging every Rotarian to lead at least two projects a year and emphasizing the importance of digital reporting to boost the district's global standing. He also shared the broader vision of District 3060, touching upon mega medical camps and the "RRR" initiative.

As the evening drew to a close with an exchange of mementos and a vote of thanks by President Elect Rtn Girish Dhar, the message was clear: at 59 years young, this club is not just resting on its laurels—it is accelerating.


The OCV was not just a visit; it was a celebration of a legacy in motion.
