Speaker Meet: PDG Prashant Jani on TRF & Social Security Scheme

The Club Meeting (2025 -2026) of RCBJ was held in Hotel Surya Palace on 17th September 2025 with a good attendance of Rotarians eager to know more on the topic of the evening.

Proceedings:

The meeting was formally called to order by Sgt-at-Arms Rtn. Ashwin Majumdar. Ann. Nita Shah sang a bhajan composed by her music teacher in praise of Mataji (as Navratri was round the corner). PP Rtn. K. S. Chhabra very eloquently reminded everyone of the 4-way test and its spiritual connotations.

President Rtn. Mitesh Vadhia in his welcome address updated the house on projects in the pipeline. He laid special emphasis on the 2 main projects of RCBJ:

1. Global grant project in Munni Ashram for solar panels
2. Flag Day Project on 7th December 2025 in partner with the army which will enhance the public image of RCBJ and the funds generated through this project will go to the families of martyrs. He thanked PP. Rtn. Bharat Shah for his contribution towards the project.

He briefly touched upon other projects like distribution of 100 sets of Bal Vatika books, tree plantation where 700 trees have already been planted from a target of 1000 trees and thanked PP. Rtn. Urmil Shah for his contribution towards the same. He also thanked PP. Rtn. Dr. Sanjay Pandit for his contribution of herbal ayurvedic plants to be made towards the Rotary Ayur Vaan project.

He requested each and every member to donate USD 25 to make RCBJ a 100% giving club.

PP. Rtn. Ashok Shah gave a brief introduction of PDG Prashant Jani , the guest of honour of the evening , after having escorted him to the dais. PDG Prashant Jani was District Governor of RID 3060 for 2020-21 and DRFC for 2022-28. Both he and his better half are members of Rotary Cub of Wadhwan City since 2001. Among the numerous accolades both are PHS and Major Level Donor Level 2.

RYE student Davin from Germany and his host PP. Rtn. Haribhai Patel and RYE student Maria with her host Rtn. Sachin Joshi were welcomed by PDG Prashant Jani.

Hon Sec. Manish Shah along with his secretarial announcements greeted all having their birthdays and Anniversaries during the fortnight.

Speaker Meet Session:

PDG Prashant Jani in his audio-visual presentation first touched upon his pet project: Social Security Scheme. This scheme would give benefits to members of Dist. 3060 only. It would render financial assistance to family of deceased Rotarians belonging to Dist. 3060. He gave detailed explanation of how this scheme would work and the fees to be paid, along with the format and nominee procedure to be followed for becoming members. He also answered questions asked by PP. Rtn. Ashutosh Jhala and PP. Rtn. Dr. Jayant Sastry.

He next took up the other half of the topic, namely The Rotary Foundation (TRF). He explained in detail how TRF was extremely important to Rotary and was actually the life line of Rotary. He explained about DRFC, ARRFC, RRFC and trustee. There is only 1 trustee for India and Rtn. Bharat Pandya is currently holding this post. He explained why it was so important to give to foundation. Our donations and contributions

1. Help society
2. Support global grant
3. In return receive DDF
4. Execute big projects

He also touched upon types of options for Foundation Giving like

1. Annual giving,
2. Restricted giving
3. Polio plus
4. Endowment fund
5. other funds.

He talked in detail about donor recognition, foundation club recognition, CSR etc .

He ended by requesting every Rotarian to make a habit of giving to the foundation since nature has only 2 options: *either give it and go OR leave it and go.*

PP. Rtn. Jagdish Thakkar in his vote of thanks assured the 'Bhanushah' of 3060 that RCBJ had taken note of all that he had said in today's meeting and thanked one and all graciously.

Meeting ended with everyone standing up for National Anthem.

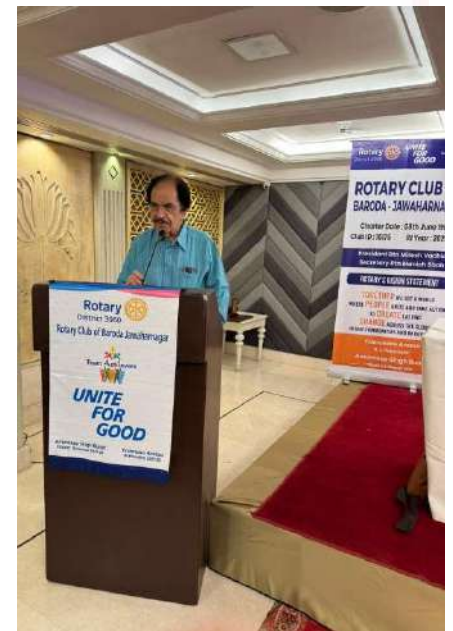
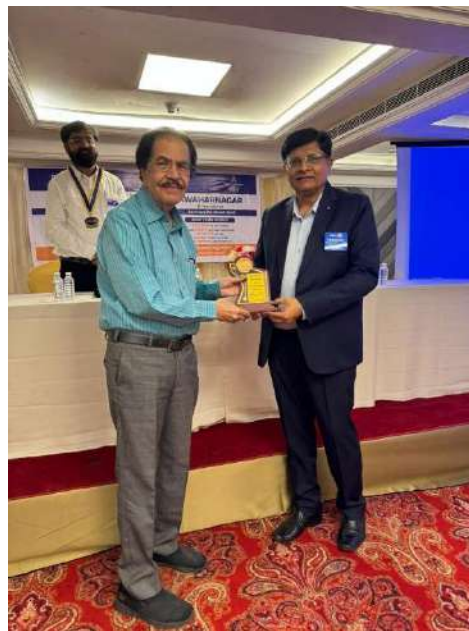
