Together with his wife of 40 years, Hemant raised two boys. All three are currently leaving in San Francisco.

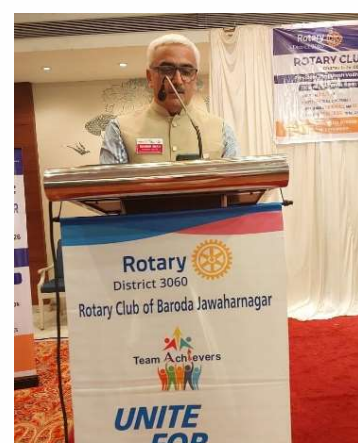
