2. NUTRITION KIT DISTRIBUTION TO TB PATIENTS

The Rotary Club of Baroda successfully conducted the distribution of nutrition kits to 100 tuberculosis (TB) patients at the Rotary Navidharti Health Centre. This initiative is part of our ongoing commitment to support TB patients with improved nutrition, which plays a vital role in their recovery process.

The club has been consistently running this project every month since 2022, demonstrating Rotary's dedication to long-term community health and disease prevention. The nutrition kits are carefully designed to include protein-rich and energy-boosting items that help patients strengthen their immune systems and adhere better to their medication regimens.

This project aligns with the Government of India's TB Mukt Bharat Abhiyan, and our efforts have been recognized by the Ministry of Health at both state and national levels. Through consistent awareness drives and on-ground support, we have not only provided nutritional aid but also educated patients and families about TB prevention and treatment.

Rotary Club of Baroda remains committed to this cause and continues to partner with health officials, NGOs, and CSR contributors to expand its reach. This ongoing service reflects our motto: "Service Above Self", and strengthens our mission of building a healthier, stronger community.

3. INSTALLS WATER COOLERS ACROSS VADODARA

Its continuous effort to serve the community, the Rotary Club of Baroda, in association with Chemcon Chemical Specialist Pvt. Ltd., has undertaken a significant initiative to install water coolers at various public locations across Vadodara. As of now, eight water coolers have been successfully installed at high-footfall areas including schools, hospitals, marketplaces, and public spaces.

This initiative ensures access to clean and cool drinking water for the general public, especially in peak summer months when dehydration-related health issues are common. Each water cooler serves over 100 people daily, making a substantial impact on public health and wellbeing.



The project not only addresses an essential need but also promotes awareness around health, hygiene, and hydration, particularly in underserved areas where clean drinking water is not readily available. The collaboration with Chemcon Chemical Specialist Pvt. Ltd. underlines the importance of CSR partnerships in driving sustainable community development.



The Rotary Club of Baroda plans to install more water coolers in the coming weeks as part of this ongoing program. Locations are selected based on community need, accessibility, and the potential to serve a large number of people.

By investing in infrastructure that offers daily utility, the club is not just responding to immediate needs but also building assets that will serve the public for years to come.
