AN INTERACTIVE SESSION WITH RTN.SHALINI BHALLA

Rtn. Shailini Bhalla is a very well-known Education consultant and a member of BJP intellectual cell. She is Woman Chair Person of Central Gujarat Chamber of Commerce and Industry. Here is a Question Answer session with her to know her and her achievements better.

Q: How did you begin your career in education?

A: My career began as a preschool teacher, where I simultaneously pursued my B.Ed. and Child Development. This dual focus helped me build a strong foundation in early childhood education and ignited my interest in innovative teaching methods.

Q: What notable contributions have you made in curriculum design?

A: At Navrachana International, I was the first to design the IB curriculum, a pioneering effort that sparked my passion for education reform. This experience paved the way for my role as an educational consultant, helping institutions develop impactful curriculum and strategies for improved learning outcomes.

Q: Can you tell us about your work with the Central Gujarat Chamber of Commerce?

A: I designed an entrepreneurship course, developed a tool for testing business skills and served as the Chairperson of the Women Entrepreneur Cell. Through this role, I aimed to empower women and promote entrepreneurial skills.

Q: What has been your role with Rotary?

A: I have designed literacy and numeracy workbooks for District 3060, which were distributed to over 10,000 schools. Currently, I am working on the Edu Skills project, focusing on equipping engineering students with employability skills.

Q: What awards have recognized your contributions?

A: I have been honoured with several awards, including:

•The Sushma Swaraj Award for my contributions to training on the New Education Policy
