At 9:00 PM, AG Vikram Premkumar contacted RC Ankleshwar President to talk about District Collector's request to provide food packets in villages affected by flood.

Members of RC Ankleshwar prepared 1800 dry food packets overnight. Moreover, demand of drinking water was huge from flooded area, so we arranged 1000 bottles were given to different areas of Ankleshwar city area and other villages too.

We provided 1200 packets yeasterday in villages 40-50 kms away from Ankleshwar. Moreover, 100 food packets were provided to the village where food packets were sent through boat.

With the help of KLJ organics Ltd Jhagadiya and Rtn PP Rajesh Nahata (CS cluster 4), RC Ankleshwar provided 200 pcs of full meal for dinner to Ankleshwar city area.

500 bottles of 1ltr drinking water was provided to Ankleshwar Div A police station to supply them to affected area by boat.

Today, more 700 dry food packets were given to rescued people of Alia Bet, Ankleshwar at Hansot APMC Jean Compound.

Rotary Club of Ankleshwar has always been on fronts in situation like this and has always came forward to do the best for the society.

There were 1-2 year old child to 90+ aged people were there and happiness on their face receiving these food and water was not measurable one.

We thank team on site and off site both who helped to make this successful.

Rotary club of Ankleshwar distributed more 100 ration kits to people of Juni Divi village. This kits were sponsored by our Rotarian Shree Vipulbhai Gajera and Neelkanth Group of Industries, Ankleshwar. 
