Yoga for the Mind Body and Soul!



Yoga Guru M R Chandrasekaran - Speaker, Meeting of Rotary Club of Adyar on 2nd Sept 2014

There is a definite air of tranquility about M R Chandrasekaran. He is a storehouse of knowledge about Yoga. Yoga is a vast subject, says he. He belts out verses in Sanskrit to explain many aspects of Yoga and its practice. M R Chandrasekaran was the speaker on the 2nd Sept 2014 Meeting of Rotary Club of Advar.

Yoga means Samadhi. Yoga is a way to realize ones Consciousness, to know the unknown spirit, to condition the body, care for the body and attain Salvation. Yoga is the coordination of the Mind, Body and Consciousness. Yoga is for introspection. It is to realize your true nature and true self.

Yoga is a way of life. There are actually 16 stages/steps to follow in order to practice Yoga ---- Satyam i.e. speak the truth, Ahimsa i.e. non violence, Appreciate others, Share and care, Discipline, Cleanliness of not only the outer body but also inner body, Desire to learn, Effort, Determination, Dedication, and finally Surrender to GOD. The actual practice of Asanas features in between, it is the 11th Stage. Yoga and Meditation -Both go hand in hand.

Yoga is skill in action. Meditation is concentration on something. Meditation is purification of the mind, healing of the mind and to get into a different stage of reality. Mind is the master of senses. Pranayama, which is also part of Yoga practice helps control the mind.

M R Chandrasekaran explained that there are 7 main Chakras in the body. There is one Asana that activates all 7 Chakras is the Surva Namaskar. The main purpose of Yoga is to massage the body and work on the organs in order to make them function well. 7000 cells in the body get activated with the practice of Yoga.

Yoga is for all - the Young and the Old. It is experiential and not experimental! 2 of his students demonstrated some popular Asanas.

The main benefits of Yoga practice are:

- · Removal of diseases · Purification of the mind
- · Inner immunity development
- · Longevity · Moral and spiritual
- · Upliftment of society



M R Chandrasekaran summed up by saying that Yoga was such a vast subject and he had touched had just the tip of the ice berg. He has been teaching Yoga for several years at the Jeeva Park, Haddows Road Park and Independence Day Park to the early risers who like to start their day with a refreshing session of Yoga.

Rtn Veeramani and President Rtn Jayaseelan contributed \$10000 each towards the Foundation.


Contribution to EREY:

Vocational Service

Vocational Service is the "Second Avenue of Service." No aspect of Rotary is more closely related to each member than a personal commitment to represent one's vocation or occupation to fellow Rotarians and to exemplify the characteristics of high ethical standards and the dignity of work. Programs of vocational service are those which seek to improve business relations while improving the quality of trades, industry, commerce and the professions. Rotarians understand that each person makes a valuable contribution to a better society through daily activities in a business or profession.

Vocational Service is frequently demonstrated by offering young people career guidance, occupational information and assistance in making vocational choices. Some clubs sponsor high school career conferences. Many recognize the dignity of employment by honoring exemplary service of individuals working in their communities. The 4 -Way Test and other ethical and laudable business philosophies are often promoted among young people entering the world of work. Vocational talks and discussion of business issues are also typical vocational service programs at most clubs. Regardless of the ways that Vocational Service is expressed, it is the banner by which Rotarians "recognize the worthiness of all useful occupations" and demonstrate a commitment to "high ethical standards in all businesses and professions." That's why the Second Avenue of Service is fundamental to every Rotary club.
