leveraging the Aranya Saptaha to meet the tree plantation targets of the District (planting more than 5 lakh trees)

Our Environment Committee will provide other ready references well before the commencement of Aranya Saptaha

In addition to the Aranya Saptaha, we would like to plant around 5000 saplings in CRPF premises as part of their tree plantation drive, for which I request whole hearted support from all the District Clubs . Minutes of 2410 RCM & 54th Installation Ceremony of Rotary Club of Belur on the 5th July, 2020

WHAT ARE ENVIRONMENTAL ETHICS AND OUR ROLE IN SAVING NATURE?

“Environmental ethics is the discipline in philosophy that studies the moral relationship of human beings to, and also the value and moral status of, the environment and its nonhuman contents.”

The definition of environmental ethics rests on the principle that there is an ethical relationship between human beings and the natural environment. Human beings are a part of the environment and so are the other living beings. When we talk about the philosophical principle that guides our life, we often ignore the fact that even plants and animals are a part of our lives. They are an integral part of the environment and hence cannot be denied their right to live. Since they are an inseparable part of nature and closely associated with our living, the guiding principles of our life and our ethical values should include them. They need to be considered as entities with the right to co-exist with human beings. Thus, it is essential that every human being respect and honor this and use morals and ethics when dealing with these creatures.

As per Nature.com, “Environmental ethics is a branch of applied philosophy that studies the conceptual foundations of environmental values as well as more concrete issues surrounding societal attitudes, actions, and policies to protect and sustain biodiversity and ecological systems.”

According to Wikipedia, “Environmental ethics is the part of environmental philosophy which considers extending the traditional boundaries of ethics from solely including humans to including the non-human world. It exerts influence on a large range of disciplines including environmental law, environmental sociology, ecotheology, ecological economics, ecology and environmental geography.”
